# Reminder for parents claiming '30 hours childcare' in the

**Spring 2024 term** All parents who are working, have a 3 or 4 year old and want to claim funded extended hours (30 hours childcare), **must** make sure they have applied to <a href="https://www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account">HMRC</a> no later than 31 December 2023. All parents with a 30 hours code need to make sure their details are up to date. They must do this every three months: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account">https://www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account</a>.

All new codes must be verified by preschool by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023, if you think you are eligible and wish to take up this funding please speak to a member of staff.

**Tax Free Childcare** If you pay childcare fees you may be able to get help with paying for this through the Tax Free Childcare scheme. Visit <a href="www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare">www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare</a> to get more information and check your eligibility.
