If you feel your child is unwell or had a bad night and you can keep your child at home please do so. Please also respect our decision if we ring you and ask you to take your child home as we are not medical professionals and are unable to distinguish between the remnants of a cold and Covid symptoms.
- Please abide by 'bubble rules' for bubble information please see our facebook page. We need to reduce the number of adults our staff interact with so please ensure the adults collecting fall into your immediate household. For working parents ONLY this includes your childcare bubble.
- Please inform us immediately if your child develops symptoms. Our preschool phone is switched on Monday to Friday 9 till 3.
